

# Mystery of wholeness – mastery of life

*“And of His **fullness** have we all received, and grace for grace” John 1:16*

Psalm 103 *“Bless the Lord O my soul, **all that is within me** bless His holy name”.*

He (Christ) Who lives in you is your “wholeness” – the “all within”. You will know He is there by the “fruits” of your spirit – peace, joy, patience, faith, hope, endurance, respect for what He has made (creation), care of the body “temple”, love of brothers and sisters in Christ, a *healing heart* of care for others - the sick, poor, strangers, little ones – this list is by no means complete.

The experience of “wholeness” is something we grow into or *become* as a seed sprouts and grows - as it grows so does the understanding. It begins with the **word of Christ** – “incorruptible seed” growing into the **fullness of Christ**. The Father said to **“Hear Him”**. When you leave your body your “wholeness” (treasure within) stays with you. The following scripture may help you to understand the mystery of wholeness *so life can work as God intends and created it to work*.

Colossians 2;9,10: *“For in Him dwells all the **fullness** of the Godhead bodily. And you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power”.1;19: “For it pleased the Father that in Him should **all fullness** dwell”. 3:16: “Let the **word of Christ** dwell in you richly....”*

Ephesians 3;14-19: *“That Christ may live in your hearts by faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; And to know the love of Christ, which passes knowledge, that you may be filled with all of the **fullness of God”**”.4:13: “Until we come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the **fullness of Christ”**”.*

John 18; 20,21: *“Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also who shall believe in Me through their word; that they may be ONE; as you Father are in Me and I in you, that they also may be one in us.15;4: “Live in Me and let Me live in you”. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can you, except you abide in Me”.*

1 Cor 3;16: *“Don’t you know that you are the temple of God and the Spirit of God lives in you?”* 13;7: Love....*“bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things”.*

The Great Commandment - *The Lord our God is one Lord: and you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength”.*

*“I have come that they might have life, and have it more abundantly” John 10:10*

**Pathway to wholeness** = teachings, disciplines, practices, prayer, study, church, refection, lifestyle control including fasting from all things harmful to the body, brain, and mind - all lead to the **“fullness or wholeness of Christ”**.
